THE ONLY COMPANY OF ITS KIND IN THE WORLD,

unlike any other TV company, be it English-speaking, Chinese or Bantu, TV5 was founded 30 years ago, on the initiative of France, Switzerland, and what would become the Wallonia/ Brussels Federation, later joined by the state of Quebec and the Canadian government. Since then, every person in the company has worked hard to turn the desire for a single voice, a common platform for the transmission of French-language productions and shared, universal values, into an everyday reality.

As the official operator of the Francophonie Summits, TV5MONDE now represents 77 states and governments through its eight channels, with programming that varies according to the region (France-Belgium-Switzerland, Europe, Africa, North Africa and Middle East, Asia, Pacific, United States, Latin America), plus a children's channel (TiVi5) and two web TV outlets (children and Africa), a status that means it is even broadcast in the lobby and offices of the United Nations Organisation in New York.

Its vocation as a worldwide French-speaking cultural broadcaster, a public service among public services (France 2, France 3, France 4, France 5, France Ô, Arte, RTS, RTBF, Radio-Canada and Télé Québec), means TV5MONDE is able to promote the entire range of French-speaking productions – cinema, TV dramas, series, documentaries, magazines, talk shows, entertainment, game shows, youth programmes, animation, variety shows, theatre, concerts, shows, and news. In 200 countries and regions, the channel is enjoyed by 243 million households with an average of 55 million viewers per week: travellers and expatriates, Francophones and Francophiles across the world who follow the programmes and learn French thanks to the subtitles in 12 languages (English, German, Spanish, Portuguese, Dutch, Romanian, Russian, Arabic, Japanese, Korean, Vietnamese and French).

TV5MONDE, with its French-speaking DNA, is a multilateral, yet unified voice. In 2013, it adopted a new set of concepts to reflect its values, with an editorial charter including an up-to-date news offering including the first ever French-speaking world newscast - 64' le monde en français - and the running time of JTAfrique increased by a third. These are both daily programmes with heavy focus on culture and French-speaking cultures in all their diversity.

With its new production, post-production and broadcasting facilities capable of ntegrating High Definition technologies, TV5MONDE will now be able to reach out to its viewers more than ever through its websites, social networks and French language learning programmes.

The latest World Population Prospects report, largely echoed by the UN, UNESCO and the IOF, forecasts an increase from 220 million French-speakers in 2010 to 400 million in 2025 and 700 million in 2050, at least 80% of whom will be in Africa. For us, our children and our grandchildren, this a wonderful opportunity in cultural, economic and strategic terms, a potential which will be reached through education but also, we are convinced, through television and the spreading of culture - these plural and diverse cultures that encourage people to learn French, adopt it and subscribe to its values.

For TV5MONDE, it is an exceptional opportunity but also an enormous responsibility. Like the generations who went before us, we do our utmost every day to rise to this historical challenge.

The editorial team at TV5MONDE, along with its partner channels, gives its viewers a plural view of world news: a Francophone, documented view of our constantly changing world, with special focus on the African continent. The news on TV5MONDE is multilateral, presented in a number of daily broadcasts, enhanced with numerous news magazines, all of which can be viewed at any time on the channel's websites.

"64' LE MONDE EN FRANÇAIS" The first ever French-speaking world newscast!

TV5MONDE has aired **"64' le monde en français"**, the first major French-speaking world newscast, **every evening at 6pm** since 27 October 2013. Thanks to its partner editorial teams (France 2, France 3, RTS, RTBF, Radio-Canada) and the expertise of its correspondents around the world, "64' le monde en français" shares and compares points of view from Paris, Geneva, Brussels, Montreal as well as Dakar, Kinshasa, Rabat and Beirut.

"64" opens with **23 minutes of international news** including, every evening, an indepth look at **the day's key event**, selected by the editors, followed by the **"Une francophone"**, a review of our partners' own newscasts, and a live analysis from a fellow journalist, a gualified personality or the editorialist, Slimane Zeghidour.

During the second half (remaining 19 minutes), the **"grand angle"** or "bigger picture" is an extended report giving witnesses or experts the chance to speak on a given topic. There is also a special theme programme every day. From Monday to Friday, Antoine Fonteneau presents the economics show, **"Le Journal de l'économie"**; on Saturdays, Isabelle Mourgère hosts **"Terriennes"** a look at the condition of women across the world, and on Sunday, it's the **"Journal des nouvelles technos"**, a special programme on new technologies.

Every day, **the Journal de la Culture "Demandez le programme"**, presented by Estelle Martin on weekdays and Jean-Baptiste Urbain at the weekend (replaced by Demet Korkmaz when absent) showcases works, trends, creators, artists and writers from the French-speaking world.

Finally, Patrick Simonin plays host to a different guest every day in **"L'Invité**", for an eight-minute interview, just before **"64" l'essentiel"** and its 4-minute condensed view of what's going on in the world.






On YouTube and Dailymotion,TV5MONDE has an official channel with trailers and video bonuses as well as special channels for its own programmes.

GOVERNANCE

plays a public service role. It is the direct operator of the Francophonie summits which bring together 77 states and governments. The decision-making bodies of TV5MONDE reflect its multilateral dimension.

THE CONFERENCE OF MINISTERS

This brings together the ministers responsible for TV5MONDE from the different governments that provide funding, namely Canada, Wallonia-Brussels Federation, France, Quebec and Switzerland, along with those from the African countries that also help finance the channel. The conference is held every two years to define and adopt the strategic direction for the channel and make sure that it is applied at TV5MONDE, while setting the contributions from the partner governments. Prior to the conference, there are a number of meetings of senior civil servants.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

This is made up of representatives of national public channels from the funding countries and chaired by the CEO of France Télévisions. Since 2008, this chair has been separate from the channel's general management. In addition, a representative from the CIRTEF and another from TV5 Quebec Canada assist the board, in an observational capacity.

THE PROGRAMME COMMITTEE

Chaired by the TV5MONDE Director of Programmes, this comprises representatives of the programme departments at TV5 Quebec Canada, France Télévisions, ARTE France, RTBF.be, RTS, Radio-Canada, Télé-Québec and the CIRTEF.

COOPERATION BOARD FOR TV5MONDE AFRICA

Made up of representatives from the six African national television channels and organisations represented on TV5MONDE's board of directors, this advisory board is chaired by TV5MONDE. Its role is to put forward general guidelines for African programmes, to promote African presence in TV5MONDE schedules and to review co-production projects.

BUDGET AND SHARE CAPITAL

SATV5MONDE's budget came to €104 million in 2013. The consolidated budget including the subsidiaries came to €108 million in 2013. Share capital is set at €137,200 divided into 9,000 shares, broken down as follows:
